Through a curated curriculum including a peer-to-peer cohort experience and dedicated 1:1 mentorship, participants build essential leadership skills, expand their networks, and lay the foundation for long-term success.

APPLICATION, COMMITMENT & TUITION

- Participants should commit to monthly cohort sessions (3 hrs duration each). In addition, participants should commit to 1-on-1 monthly mentor meetings (1.5 hrs. duration each)
- **Tuition: \$8,000** (This includes monthly sessions, StrengthsFinder assessment, course materials, and participation in Conexión's special events)
